

The **DriveNOW** Program is a twelve-week training program that prepares Norfolk City residents for a career as a **Bus Operator** with **Hampton Roads Transit (HRT).**



The program, entirely free for eligible participants, is a partnership among Norfolk Works, Tidewater Community College, and HRT to offer training that will equip residents with a learners Commercial Driver's License (CDL), a Virginia Career Readiness Certificate, and customer service and workplace essential skills.

Classes will be held Monday through Friday, from 8:00am to 5:00pm. After successful completion of this program, participants will have offered for **full-time employment with HRT as a Bus Operator**. Once hired, participants will receive additional on-the-job training to earn their permanent CDL B license.

2 Employment Requirements

- Valid VA Driver's License (issued on or before 11/02/2018)
- GED <u>or</u> High School Diploma <u>or</u> passing TABE testing score (testing provided)
- Drug screening
- Criminal background check (no pending charges or convictions of any barrier crimes)
- Ability to meet the required Medical Examiner's criteria.

3 DMV Requirements

- Not failed the CDL Learners Permit test more than one time.
- Must have active driver's license for at least two years (issued on or before 11/02/2018)
- No DWI/DUI convictions within the last 5 years.

4 Job Requirements

Must be willing to work overnight, weekends, holidays, split shifts and during inclement weather
