Norfolk is a Major Multi-Modal Hub on the East Coast

Norfolk is served by Amtrak, light rail, and two commercial rail lines (CSX and Norfolk Southern). Amtrak provides daily service to the Northeast Corridor via Richmond, Washington D.C., New York City, and Boston.



Norfolk International Airport (ORF) is the primary airport serving Hampton Roads and northeast North Carolina. \$100 million in improvements are underway.

In partnership with the City of Norfolk, Hampton Roads Transit embarked on the environmental review process (DEIS) to evaluate a possible extension of high capacity transit to the Tide. Potential future connections include the Military Circle/Military Highway area and JANAF Shopping Center, Sentara Leigh Hospital, Norfolk International Airport, and Naval Station Norfolk.



The Cruise Industry has expanded its stops in Norfolk and draws consumers from Maryland to North Carolina for international travel.

Micro Mobility projects include e-scooters, bike lanes, and Pace Bike Share.

The Hampton Roads Bridge-Tunnel Expansion Project will ease congestion with the addition of twin 2-lane bored tunnels just west of the existing eastbound tunnel. The 4-lane segments of the I-64 corridor in Hampton and Norfolk will be widened. Project Budget is \$3.8 billion. Completion in 2025. hamptonroadsconnector.com
